(c) Eligibility Criteria:

Essential:-

- (i) Matriculation or equivalent
- (ii) Should qualify a trade entrance examination.
- (iii) Should have successfully completed apprenticeship from a recognized/ reputed workshop inthe relevant trade under

Apprenticeship Act 1961 or under any other recognized Apprenticeship Scheme.

OR

Should have completed training course in the relevant trade from an ITI recognized for this purpose and have 1 year trade experience.

OR

4 years experience in the trade for which no training is available in the Industrial Training Institute or other recognized institutions.

(d) Age Limit and Relaxations.

2. <u>How to Apply</u>. Application form should be filled either in English or Hindi as per the prescribed format given at **Annexure-I**. The applications with duly **affixed self attested colour photograph** should be accompanied by photocopies of the documents listed below, duly self attested with name and

date. No original certificates are to be forwarded alongwith the application form:-

- (a) Valid Photo ID proof
- (b) Date of birth proof (Class X mark sheet OR Birth certificate).
- (c) Matriculation or equivalent marksheet and certificate.
- (d) 12th/UG/PG/Diploma marksheet and certificate as per the essential eligibility.
- (e) Latest Category certificate (SC/ST) for reserved category Candidates as per the prescribed format given at **Annexure-II**.
- (f) Experience certificate (if applicable).
- (g) NOC'No Objection Certificate' from the employer for presently serving in any Government Organization (if applicable).
- (h) Two latest passport size colour photographs.
- (j) Applicants are to enclose a separate blank envelope with Rs. 50/- postal stamp (pasted on the envelope) addressed to themselves with the application.

Note:-

- (i) The date of issue of all the above documents is to be on or before to closing date of application i.e. 28 Oct 2024. The crucial date for reckoning the eligibility with regards to age and educational qualification etc. will be the last date for receipt of applications.
- (ii) Reserved category candidates applying against unreserved post will not be entitled for age relaxation.
- 3. The duly filled applications alongwith all the requisite documents should be forwarded to The Commander, Coast Guard Region (A&N), Post Box No.716, Haddo (PO), Port Blair 744 102, A&N Islands by ordinary post only within 45 days from the date of publication of the advertisement in the Employment News.

4. Mode of Selection.

- (a) <u>Scrutiny of Applications</u>. All applications received from the candidates will be scrutinized subject to the eligibility criteria and necessary documents and the admit cards will be issued to the shortlisted candidates for document verification and appearing in the written examination.
- (b) <u>Document Verification</u>. All the shortlisted candidates will undergo document verification prior appearing in the written examination. Candidates will be required to bring their original documents and self-attested photocopies (02 sets) of the same as per the directives/ instructions given in their admit cards.
- (c) <u>Written Examination</u>. All the shortlisted candidates will undergo written examination which will consist of subjects in General English, General Knowledge, Simple Maths and relevant trade questions based on the educational/technical qualifications prescribed for the post. The written examination will be pen-paper based and one hour duration. The Question Paper (bilingual) for written examination will consists of 80 objective type questions with one mark for each correct answer and there will be no negative marking. Candidates who qualify the written test are to be shortlisted for the trade test (where applicable), which is qualifying in nature.

- (d) **Skill Test.** The candidates who qualify the written test will be called for skill test (as applicable), which is qualifying in nature.
- (e) <u>Merit list.</u> Merit list will be prepared strictly based on merit position as per marks obtained in written examination and will be published on the Indian Coast Guard website alongwith necessary instructions.

5. <u>Important Instructions to Candidates</u>:-

- (a) Before applying for the post, the candidates should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility and other norms mentioned in the advertisement. Furnishing of wrong/ false information will lead to disqualification and ICG will not be responsible for any consequence of furnishing of such wrong/false information.
- (b) Candidature of the candidate is liable to be rejected at any stage of recruitment process or after recruitment or joining, if any, information provided by the candidate is found false or is not found in conformity with eligibility criteria mentioned in the advertisement.
- (c) It is mandatory that the envelope containing the application should be clearly superscribed in BOLD letters with notation "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF _____" and also the category for which they applied for viz. UR/EWS/OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/SC/ST. Applications without these notations will be summarily rejected.
- (d) Applications with the following deficiencies will be summarily rejected:-
 - (i) Incomplete applications.
 - (ii) Applications found over aged on the last day of receipt of applications as per advertisement.
 - (iii) Overwriting/ cuttings/ corrections/ incorrect information according to enclosures.
 - (iv) Photographs not affixed.
 - (v) Photocopies of self attested documents not found enclosed.
 - (vi) A separate blank envelope with Rs. 50/- postal stamp (pasted on the envelope) addressed to themselves, not enclosed with the application.
- (e) Candidates working in Govt departments are to forward their application through proper channel only before the due date of receipt of application alongwith NOC issued by concerned authority.
- (f) SC/ST candidates are entitled for 2nd class rail/ bus fare by shortest route as per Govt rules and the same will be reimbursed at the venue of written examination on submission of tickets. The above concessions are not admissible to those Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes candidates who are already in Central/ State Govt service.
- (g) Mere appearance/ qualifying in the written examination does not confer any right on the candidate to claim for appointment unless he/she fulfils the eligibility criteria.
- (h) Candidates selected for appointment to a Group 'C' post are liable for posting initially at any unit/establishment under Coast Guard Region (A&N) with all India transfer liability.
