India aims to reset AI debate with 1st Global South summit

Event To Push Cooperation On Reskilling, Workforce Transitions

New Delhi: Unthinkable just a few years ago, when artificial intelligence was a shiny experiment — impressive demos, niche tools, and a buzzword that rarely touched daily life — today it sits at the heart of how jobs are created, services delivered, science conducted and societies governed. As the world grapples with both its promise and its risks, India is stepping into a new role, as not just a user of AI but also as a global agenda-setter, becoming the first developing country and the first nation from the Global South to convene a global AI summit.

Speaking exclusively to TOI, Abhishek Singh, CEO of India AI Mission and AI Impact Summit, believes that this is India's attempt to pull the global AI debate away from elite labs and corporate boardrooms and anchor it in people, inclusion and real-world outcomes.

"This is the first summit of its kind and scale being hosted in the Global South," said Singh, adding, "AI today is largely controlled by a few countries and a few companies. India wants to bring the perspective of the Global South and ensure that AI is more inclusive and democratised."

India's case for hosting the summit, Singh said, rests on experience rather than theory. Over the past decade, platforms such as Aadhaar, UPI, DigiLocker and telemedicine have shown how digital systems

Nvidia CEO unable to attend AI Summit

Nvidia CEO Jensen Huang, who was to be one of the biggest attractions at the India AI Impact Summit starting on Monday, will not be able to travel to India for the event. The company issued a statement Saturday, ascribing it to "unforeseen circumstances".

Huang was expected to play a prominent role at the summit — set to be inaugurated by PM Modi.

Nvidia is the world's most valuable company, with a market capitalisation of \$4.4 trillion, thanks to its processors that have become indispensable to the training of AI models. Persons familiar with the development told TOI that Huang is under the weather. Nvidia said a senior delegation led by executive vice-president Jay Puri will attend the event to "celebrate India's exceptional AI researchers, startups, developers, and partners building country's AI infrastructure."

can operate at population scale, delivering services to hundreds of millions.

"India has shown its ability to adopt technology for public services," said Singh. "We want to showcase India's strength in building AI applications at population scale and also be the voice of the Global South."

The summit comes at a time when govts worldwide are struggling to balance rapid AI innovation with growing concerns over deepfakes, misinformation, bias and misuse. While there is broad

agreement that AI should drive economic growth and social good, Singh said translating principles into practice remains uneven.

"Every country agrees on two things: AI must be used for larger social good; and harm from AI must be restricted," he said. "But countries are at very different levels of technological development. That is where regulatory capacity and shared frameworks become important." India's approach, he explained, is based on what it calls a 'techno-legal framework',

combining legal safeguards with technological tools. Legal provisions require harmful content to be taken down within defined timelines and mandate labelling of AI-generated content, especially where it poses risks to individuals, public order or national security. Alongside this, India is developing tools to detect deepfakes, mitigate bias and create ethical AI certification systems.

A major focus of the summit is human capital. As automation reshapes work and threatens traditional livelihoods, the summit aims to push global cooperation on reskilling and workforce transitions, particularly for developing economies facing resource constraints.

"AI should not grow only in tech hubs," Singh said. "We are setting up data labs across the country, centres of excellence in states and smaller cities, and running large-scale skilling and training programmes so that AI reaches tier-2 and tier-3 cities." Inclusion is another central theme, with India highlighting the role of Indian-language and voice-based AI systems in expanding access. Platforms built on natural language processing and generative AI allow people to access services in their own languages, especially those uncomfortable with English.

The summit's agenda also spans AI-enabled scientific research in healthcare, agriculture and climate, while pushing for openness, reproducibility and shared standards.

Generative AI ups demand for skilled workers: Study

New Delhi: The introduction of generative AI has resulted in moderation in hiring at the entry level, increased demand for skilled mid-level workers, and provided "considerable stability" at senior level, an ICRIR study has said.

Researchers note this moderation aligns with broader post-pandemic trends in the IT industry and cannot be attributed to AI adoption alone. Roles commonly perceived as most exposed to AI, such as software developers and database administrators, are

also among those experiencing the strongest growth in demand, indicating that generative AI is primarily functioning as a productivity-enhancing complement to technical and analytical work, rather than a substitute," said the report, which was backed by OpenAI and based on a survey of over 650 firms.

Roles such as statisticians and mathematicians, application developers and database designers and administrators were among the most exposed — and had the highest demand — while HR, legal and finance professionals were least. The most impact

ed roles and skills include data entry and clerical work, followed by manual testing, manual quality assurance, and entry level programming. Among business functions in IT companies, software development and engineering, followed by IT infra and cloud services and project management were seen to be the most affected, the survey showed. The report said AI adoption is reshaping hiring priorities toward hybrid skills profiles combining domain expertise and AI and data-related technical skills, instead of narrow specialisation.

While half the companies surveyed said they were investing in internal awareness and workforce reskilling, the report said: "The cause for concern, however, is that IT firms are not hiring enough workers with skills in large language model operations or expanding their R&D divisions, and most importantly, are not investing adequately in training and upskilling. The shortage of qualified AI trainers, limited AI skills among new labour market entrants, and policy and regulatory uncertainty surrounding AI are challenges that must be urgently addressed."

The venue will also have 20-25 anti-sabotage teams, along with bomb detection and disposal squads, to conduct continuous security sweeps. These teams are already

inspecting every nook and corner of the site, as well as surrounding areas, to detect and neutralise any potential risk. Five teams of the NDRF will be deployed to tackle any kind of disaster, and two teams have been kept in reserve.

Steps are also being taken to ensure no protests or demonstrations are held around the venue.

Twenty-five teams with wireless sets and buses will coordinate, and if there is any chance of a gathering,

FM: We spend 5.6% of GDP on climate action

New Delhi: Finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman on Saturday said India has hiked spending on climate action in



past six years to 5.6% of GDP, demonstrating the country's pursuit of meeting nationally determined goals on curbing carbon emission.

Participating in a panel discussion at Munich Security Conference, she said India has increased its commitment to climate action. "Six years ago, we were spending 3.7% of our GDP on climate action. Today, that figure is close to 5.6%," she said.

She said India will continue to invest in renewable energy, and has been steadily building on that commitment. Carbon capture strategies have been funded in Union Budget 2026-27 so that they can be implemented across country, she said, adding that they are being 'incentivised'.

She said India achieved two-thirds of its nationally determined commitments in the renewable sector four years ahead of the target date. PTI

Manappuram gets RBI nod for Bain acquisition

Mumbai: RBI has cleared Bain Capital's proposed acquisition of joint control in Manappuram Finance, marking a key regulatory milestone for a deal struck in 2025.

Manappuram said it received the final approval on Feb 13 for affiliates of Bain Capital to acquire joint control and hold up to 41.6% of its paid-up equity capital or convertible instruments. The approval relates to definitive agreements executed on March 20, 2025.

Under the agreement, Bain Capital committed to invest Rs 4,385 crore to acquire an 18% stake in a fully diluted basis through a preferential allotment of equity shares and warrants at Rs 236 a share. The transaction also triggers a mandatory offer open to buy an additional 26% from public shareholders at the same price, in line with takeover regulations.

With the RBI approval, Bain Capital will be classified as a promoter and will jointly control the company along with the existing promoters. Manappuram said its board will be reconstituted to include nominee directors of Bain Capital, as provided for in the transaction agreements. PTI

Rlys promises clean toilets in general, unreserved coaches

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New Delhi: Railways is seeking to address the biggest concern of long-distance passengers — train toilets. On Saturday, it rolled out reforms in on-board services with focus on regular cleaning of toilets, wash basins and garbage collection in trains on the move, including for millions of passenger travelling in general or unreserved coaches to have access to cleaned toilets.

This is a sharp contrast to the current practice where toilets, basins and common areas in general coaches of moving trains are not cleaned at regular intervals unless there is a complaint.

A top railway official said this provision is being introduced for the first time. Railways minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said, "In the current mechanism, cleaning is done only in reserved coaches. We have included general coaches in the new reform."

Vaishnaw also said the earlier "clean train station" concept is now being replaced with a continuous cleaning model from the train's origin to its destination. "Toilets, garbage bins, cabin interiors, water availability and minor electrical or mechanical defects such as lights going out will be addressed continuously during the journey," he said.

He announced two reforms — for better on-board services, and rail-based logistics through Gati Shakti

cargo terminals and cargo-related facilities — as a part of its target to implement '52 Reforms in 52 weeks in 2026'.

To begin with, around 80 long-distance trains with high passenger patronage — 4-5 trains per zone — will be covered under reforms relating to on-board services in the next six months. Vaishnaw said fully technology-enabled professional teams will be engaged with defined service level agreements, specifying cleaning frequency and more frequent cleaning during peak hours.

Vaishnaw said the linen distribution, collection, and cleaning functions, which were earlier distributed among separate agencies, will also now be integrated and awarded to a single entity.

He said reforms in the cargo terminal segment are expected to generate around Rs 30,000 crore additional revenue from new Gati Shakti cargo terminals (GCTs) in the next three years.

To drive startup eco system, Cabinet gives nod to set up ₹10,000cr fund

New Delhi: The Cabinet has approved the launch of Urban Challenge Fund with total central assistance of Rs 1 lakh crore over five years, to help states tackle the day-to-day challenges of rapid urbanisation and steer creative redevelopment of cities, positioning them as growth hubs. It also approved establishment of Startup India Fund of Funds 2.0 with a corpus of Rs 10,000 crore to mobilise venture capital for the startup ecosystem in the country.

Announcing the decisions, I&B minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said UCF will focus on creative redevelopment of cities, developing them as growth hubs and strengthening water and sanitation systems to drive transformative, market-linked urban infrastructure creation. The Centre-sponsored scheme was announced in 2025-26 Budget.

Under this framework, central assistance will cover 25% of a project's cost, provided that at least 50% of the funding is mobilised from the market. Govt said this will catalyse a total investment of Rs 4 lakh crore in the urban

sector over the next five years. "The move marks a paradigm shift in India's urban new development approach from grant-based financing to market-linked, reform-driven and outcome-oriented infrastructure creation," it said. UCF will leverage market financing, private sector participation and citizen-centric reforms to deliver high-quality urban infrastructure.

All cities with a population of 10 lakh or more, all state capitals and major industrial cities with a population of more than one lakh can avail the fund. All municipal areas in hilly and NE states, as well as smaller ones with a population below 1 lakh, will be eligible for support under Credit Repayment Guarantee Scheme, with Rs 5,000 crore having been approved for it.

Ex-lovers found dead in locked car on Noida road

Noida: A 32-year-old man and a 28-year-old woman were found dead with gunshot wounds inside a locked car in Sector 107 in Noida on Saturday afternoon. Police are investigating the twin deaths as murder-suicide, based on a message in the man's phone that indicated he had killed

his ex-girlfriend before turning the gun on himself.

The two were identified as Rekha, a resident of Salarpur, a resident of Triokpur in Delhi. Rekha worked in a private company in Sector 162, while Sumit had a mineral water plant business.

The deaths were discovered around 1pm on Saturday

when locals found a suspiciously parked car near Dadri Road, police said. Passersby found a man, with a gun in his hand, and a woman, bleeding and unconscious in their seats, after which they alerted the police. A team from the Sector 39 police station broke open a window and discovered both dead from head gunshot wounds.
